Ordinance 156 adopted by Council and Effective 05/28/2002

Section 1. Permit Required:

 No person shall, for hire, gain or reward, operate any snow removal equipment upon the sidewalks or thoroughfares of the Village of Grosse Pointe Shores without first obtaining an annual permit from the office of the Village Clerk.

Section 2. Term:

1. All permits are granted under the provisions of the Ordinance shall expire on October 31st of each year and shall not be transferable.

Section 3. Application Fee and Bond:

- 1. The Village Clerk shall issue a permit upon satisfactory completion of permit application, the payment of \$100.00 permit fee and the execution of a bond to the Village of Grosse Pointe Shores in the sum of \$5,000.00 as approved in for by the Village attorney.
- 2. No permit shall be issued by the Village Clerks office until the application permit fee and bond have been filed and approved by said office.
- 3. Upon approval, the Village Clerk shall issue a permit which shall be permanently affixed to the right front window of the permit holder's vehicle.
- 4. A snow removal permit shall be valid for one vehicle only. Additional permits for additional vehicles shall be issued upon payment of \$25.00 per each vehicle.

Section 4. Safety Lighting:

1. Each vehicle shall be equipped with top mounted yellow flashing or rotating safety light visible to 200 feet.

Section 5. Removal of Snow:

- Permit holder shall shovel, plow, push, discharge or move snow onto any thoroughfare or sidewalk in the Village of Grosse Pointe Shores provided that snow may be moved over a thoroughfare to a median or to private property if permission under Section 5(2) has been granted so long as no snow remain on said thoroughfare so as to impede vehicular traffic.
- 2. No permit holder shall shovel, plow, push, discharge or move snow onto private property of any resident of the Village of Grosse Pointe Shores without first obtaining permission from said property owner.

Section 6. Non-Commercial Operation:

The provisions of this Ordinance shall not be applicable to a resident owner, or lease who by means of a motor driven device removes snow from the sidewalk contiguous to his premises.

Section 7. Penalty:

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance upon conviction thereof shall be punished by the imposition of a fine not to exceed \$500.00

Section 8. Conflicting Ordinances:

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herein are herby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

Section 9. Effective Date:

The Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after its passage by the Village Council.
