Tree limbs and branches (brush) must be placed at the curb in lengths of four feet or shorter and tied in bundles weighing less than 50 pounds.

COLLECTIONS OF LEAVES: This (curb-side) service begins on Tuesday, October 10th and ends Friday, December 1st. Place leaves in the gutter of the roadway to be picked up. Lake Shore Road residents need to place the leaves on the grass just behind the curb. Pickup will coincide with your regular household rubbish day.
