Approval of March 8, 2021 meeting minutes motioned and seconded; unanimously
approved.

Old Business:

- A. Corrective Action Plan with SEMSD-HRC is preparing to submit an extension
request for consent decree.
- B. Sewer System Upgrades/Costs-Bonding company estimated the rate at 3%
for roughly \$7.2 million over 25 or 30 years.
- C. Lake Shore Rd. Sewall Replacement & Timeline-Wayne County-The county is
attempting to find money and our federal representatives are trying to find
funding in appropriations to pay for this project.

New Business:

- A. Oxford Rd. Rebuild-Sanitary System and Water System are in subpar
condition, road continues to be patched. Potable water infrastructure needs
to be upgraded. Looking at combining these projects with the sewer upgrade
to complete as on infrastructure package.
- B. Driveway and stairway to City Hall are looking to be replaced.
- C. Panels in the outer seawall are being worked on as the welder becomes
available.
