A Grosse Pointe Shores Harbor Committee meeting was held on Thursday, June 11, 2020 at the Grosse Pointe Shores Osius Park Pavilion, 800 Lake Shore Rd.

**Approval of Minutes**

Approval of draft minutes of the March 3, 2020 Harbor Committee regular meeting motion by Kratz, seconded by Schroder; unanimously approved.

**Harbor Master Report**

Krolczyk reported that he is currently in discussion with the contractor to replace deteriorating decking boards on three of the main docks. Rental fees for the 2020 season should surpass \$200,000. Krolczyk stated we are still receiving calls for boat wells and are renting what is left available. D'Hondt asked if a trash receptacle could be placed at the northeast corner of the harbor. Krolczyk responded that there was once a container placed in that spot but was in way of waves and storms coming over the seawall. We will look into placement of another.

**Old Business**

Committee members were given a final revision of the harbor rules to review and approve at the next meeting.

Krolczyk stated that the water levels have exceed last year's high mark and currently DPW has a sand dam and seven pumps installed to keep the water out of the park.

Ritter stated that there is an exposed steel angle in the harbor that should probably have rubber placed over it to avoid boat damage. Krolczyk stated that he would look into.
